

Subject: STC Retired Employees Medical Scheme, 1981 – Amendment

In modification of Circular No: IR/12/2019 dated 18.06.2019, with the approval of Competent Authority, it has been decided that

- i) Inclusion of COVID-19, Swine flu/H1N1 flu as life threatening infections/diseases in the existing STC (Retired) Medical Benefit Scheme-1981 along with other five life threatening diseases.
 - ii) Claims received from ex-employee(s) on account of treatment of COVID-19; Swine flu/H1N1 flu be considered for reimbursement within the prescribed ceiling as per the norms of extant STC (Retired) Medical Benefit Scheme-1981. Treatment for COVID-19 obtained in non empanelled hospital will be honoured /restricted within the prescribed ceiling.
2. The above amendment will come into force with immediate effect.
 3. The other terms and conditions of the Scheme remained unchanged.
